


## **Cascade Gateway Border Data**

Note: All data is personal vehicle passengers crossing into the US. Does not include pedestrians, bus, or rail passengers. (based on US Bureau of Transportation Statistics)



US entries at the Cascade Gateway were down 25% in 2023 compared to 2019. Pt. Roberts volumes were down 32%, which is higher than the average for other regional crossings when combined, but slightly better than Sumas.





Compared to the national scale, recovery at our regional crossings has been slower when comparing 2023 to 2019 as well as the month of March 2024 (latest available data) compared to March 2019. However, volumes at all three scales are steadily recovering post-pandemic. Pt. Roberts lags behind the national average and behind the Cascade Gateway overall (which includes Pt. Roberts, Sumas, Lynden, Blaine).
