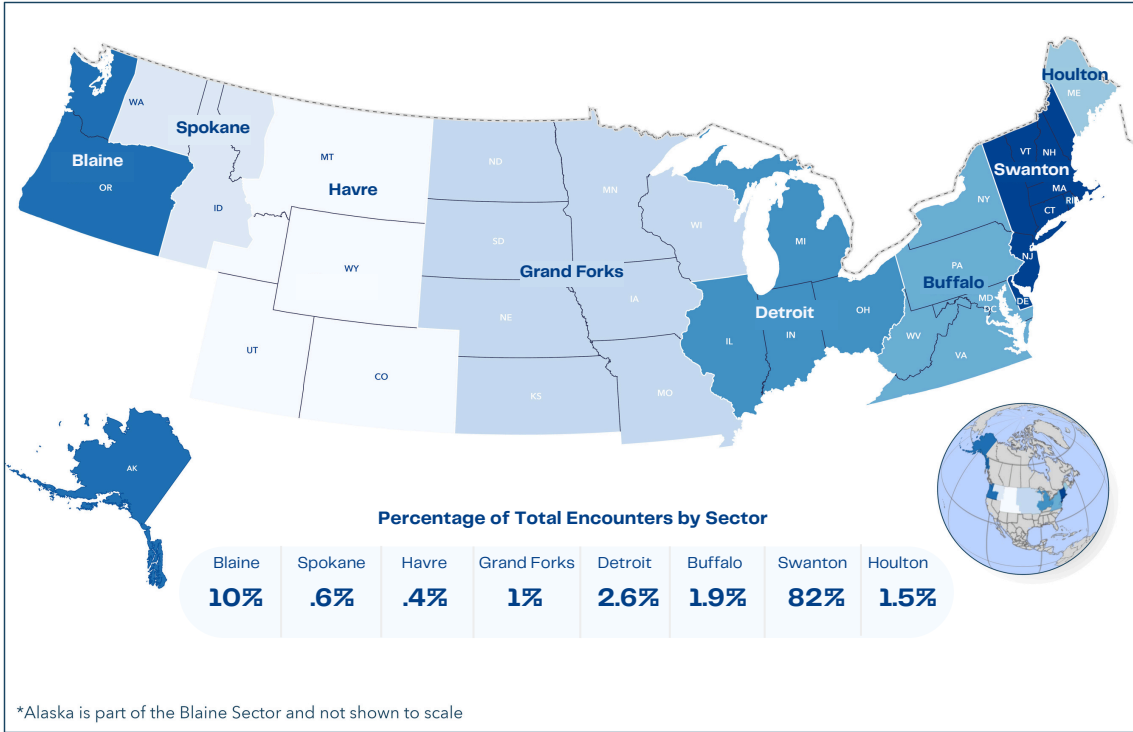


# 2024 NORTHERN US BORDER PATROL ENCOUNTERS BY SECTOR JURISDICTION



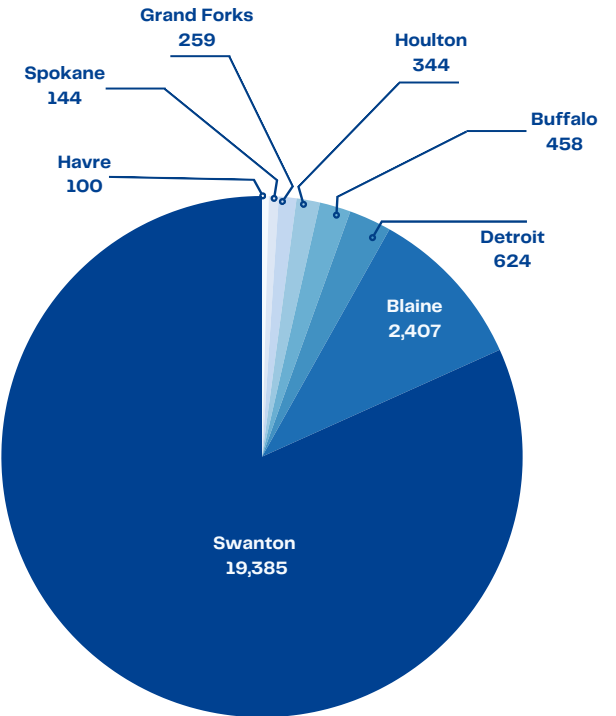

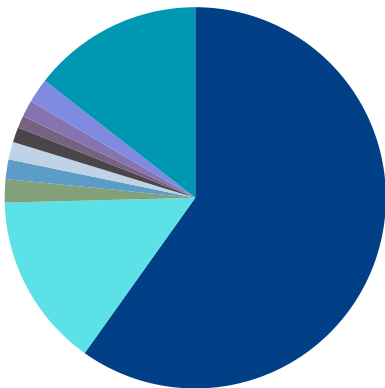
**Encounters:** The sum of U.S. Border Patrol (USBP) Title 8 apprehensions. BP sector encounters occur outside of official ports of entry.

**Title 8 Enforcement Actions** refers to apprehensions processed under CBP's immigration authority. Apprehensions refers to the physical control or temporary detention of a person by USBP between POEs who is not lawfully in the U.S. which may or may not result in an arrest.
